Everybody probably read that the state attorney informed SA Hunters of the intention by SA Police to recall a 2009 High Court interdict that maintained the validity of the old green firearm licence. The advice from SAGA to those who are only in possession of the green licences is that steps should be taken to transition to the FCA. Affected members must do the required proficiency tests and obtain the relevant competency certificate(s) and then apply for the relevant license(s).
